The goal is to have all does milk to their potential, particularly in early and mid lactation. This is often challenging, particularly in early lactation when does are constrained for a variety of reasons.

Low dry matter intake and “level” grain feeding in more conventional feeding systems often limits does from reaching their potential milk production. High producing does require higher levels of protein and energy to help meet their specific requirements.

Feeding a topdress supplement allows producers to specifically target those animals with the potential for higher production in early lactation. This is a cost effective way to target nutrition and give animals the opportunity to produce to their potential.



Specific formulation

Feed the **SHUR-GAIN 30% Dairy Goat Topdress Supplement** to high producing early lactation does at a rate of 150 to 300 grams / head / day. Split this amount into two feedings or feed whole amount during a third grain feeding of the day. Make sure does have access to clean, fresh water at all times.
